ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Navigating friendships at any age can be tricky and school is such an important place for children to start to practice these skills. They don't always get things right and that's okay, as it's all part of the learning process.

Teachers assist in many ways, explicitly teaching interpersonal skills, and delicately guiding children to navigate their own way to resolve friendship issues with a restorative approach, building on respect and understanding. For parents there is no magic formula when our children encounter friendship problems, as so many do. Talking to them without judgement, offering simple suggestions, alongside modelling, reflecting and discussing your own personal experiences with friendships can provide some support and comfort. If your child isn't ready to talk, let them know that they can always come to you. Open communication with your child's teacher is encouraged, if you have any concerns regarding supporting your children in their social/emotional development.



NATIONAL CONSISTENT COLLECTION OF DATA, SCHOOL STUDENTS WITH DISABILITY

The NCCD is an annual assessment of the number of students with disability receiving educational adjustments to allow them to participate in schooling on the same basis as students without disability. The collection of data is completed by every school in Australia. No collection notice or consent form is required to be completed for the collection of data. The NCCD is not just about counting students, it is designed to provide schools and governments with a better understanding of students with disability, drawing on work of teachers and education staff and the information collected by schools.

The National Data Collection will assist schools to:

- Gain a greater understanding of their students population and how students can be best supported
- Formally and consistently recognise the support and adjustments provided to students with disability
- Develop the professional judgement of school teams in making educational adjustments for students with disability rather than relying on a medical or clinical diagnosis alone
- Review their learning and support systems and continually improve educational outcomes for students with disabilities

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ's)

Q. What happens to lost property at the end of the term?

A. If the clothing cannot be identified via an attached marking or name tag, one of several things will happen. Non-school uniform clothing is sent to charities. School uniform items are washed and forwarded either to our sickbay for use in cases when children require an immediate change of clothing for some reason, or to our second-hand uniform shop for resale. There's still time for you to check whether we have any of your child's clothing in our lost property and collect it – and we have quite a lot.
