# Assistant Principals' Report

## RELATIONSHIPS AND SEXUAL HEALTH IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS

This evening at 6:00 PM - 7:00 PM AEST (1 hour) Parents of students in years 5 will be invited to attend an online parent information session, exploring content from the Relationship and Sexual Health in Primary Schools program. This event will be run by Sexual Health Victoria. Angela Maskery and Kerry Worthington will deliver the content of the program to the grade 5 students. We strongly recommend that parents attend this information session in preparation for the program to be delivered to the students this term. The link to access the session has been emailed to parents this morning.

## BORROWING CLOTHING FROM SICKBAY

We have many children who are required to borrow clothing items from sick bay. Could those families please ensure that these items are washed and returned as soon as possible. It is a good idea to pack a change of clothes in your children's school bag in case of accidents and emergencies.

## RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS

**Myth:** Respectful Relationships teaches radical gender theory.

**Fact:** Respectful Relationships does not teach radical gender theory. It is a primary prevention initiative to reduce family violence. Respectful Relationships promotes respect and gender equality and helps students learn how to build healthy relationships.

## SCHOOL ATTENDANCE

Going to school every day is the single most important part of your child's education. Students learn new things at school every day. Students who are regularly absent from school are at risk of missing fundamental aspects of their educational and social development. The Victorian Government's "Everyday Counts" initiative promotes the fact that regular school attendance enables students to maximise their full potential and to actively participate and engage in their learning. It is important that children develop habits of regular attendance at an early age. Children with attendance of 80 per cent or less (that is, 40 days or more absenteeism per year) may be significantly disadvantaged in their learning. If you are having attendance issues with your child, please let your child's teacher know so we can work together to get your child to school every day. Our Assistant Principal or school staff will contact you if there are any concerns about your child's attendance or punctuality. Remember **EVERYDAY COUNTS!**

## RESPECTFUL RELATIONSHIPS



## Fun for kids and easy for parents

We understand that finding time to take your child to see the dentist can be very hard and time consuming, which is why we provide the service of having dentistry coming to you. Your child will receive quality dental treatment from our highly trained and professional dental team, all of whom are working with children certified.

We will also provide information to your child about the importance of maintaining great oral health, and we will ensure your child loves coming back to the dentist.



## Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS)

With assistance from the Government, Medicare has introduced a Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) that provides children access to basic dental services from the ages of 2-17 years old. The entitlement is capped at \$1,052 per child for every two calendar year period.

**To be eligible**, you or the child must be claiming one of the following benefits: Family Tax Benefits-Part A, Parenting Payment, Abstudy, Youth Allowance, Carer's Payment, Disability Support Pension, Special Benefits or Double Orphan Pension. To enquire if your child is eligible, please contact Medicare on 132 011.

Once your child's forms have been returned to your school and received by us, we will individually check each child's eligibility to see if treatment can be bulk billed through Medicare.

If your child is **not eligible** for the CDBS Funding, Teeth On Wheels can offer a special deal that is only available through your school for a check-up, clean and fluoride treatment (and x-rays if required) for only \$99 (pre-payment required) which can be up to 30% cheaper than a private practice.

Our service also provides children to be seen under **Private Health Insurance**, as most providers will offer two free check-ups and clean per family member each calendar year. To make a claim, you pay \$99 to Teeth On Wheels and we will provide you with an invoice to claim your treatment back through your Private Health Fund.

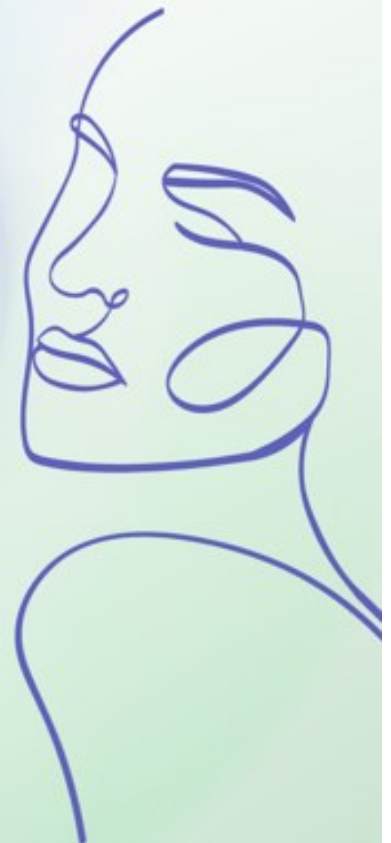
