SAFE AROUND SCHOOLS



Our actions as drivers & carers are one of the most important ways for children to be safe around our school. We can all work together to:

- Follow the signs
- Reduce our speed around the school
- Keep the pick-up zone moving
- Respect our school crossing supervisors and as drivers be aware of the rules around school crossings.
- Be courteous and aware and not distracted while driving.

Distracted driving is doing another activity that takes the driver's attention away from driving. Distracted driving can increase the chance of a motor vehicle crash. Sending a text message, talking on your phone, using a navigation system and eating while driving are just a few examples of distracted driving.

- Drivers are 10 times more at risk of crashing if they are using their phone
- 1/3 of drivers admit to using their phone illegally while driving
- Taking your eyes off the road for only **2** seconds or more doubles your crash risk.
- At 50km you will travel 28 metres in 2 seconds, that's about the length of a cricket pitch!
- The penalty for using your mobile phone device while driving is \$577 fine and 4 demerit points.
